**A World of Discovery**

**AHI Connects | Curanto Lunch.** Visit the small fishing village of Calbuco to relish a curanto, the Chilean cultural tradition of cooking a hearty stew inside a pit over hot stones. Savor the flavorful stew for lunch!

**Santiago Tour.** Discover Chile's dynamic capital city on a panoramic tour, with some stops along the way. Marvel at La Moneda Palace, Plaza de Armas' historic square, the bohemian Bellavista area and the urban Parque Forestal. Visit the Chilean Museum of Pre-Columbian Art and Plaza de Armas.

**Winery Tour.** Visit an 1856 Chilean winery, for a tour and a reserve wine tasting.

**Chiloé Island.** Take a ferry ride across the Canal de Chacao to visit this remote island. Stroll Chacao's town square and then take a small boat to witness a penguin colony in its natural habitat. Head to the Museum of the Churches of Chiloé to admire miniature models of the island's UNESCO churches.

**The Lakes Region.** Head to Petrohué to behold the jaw-dropping natural spectacle of its eponymous, turquoise river falls. Next take a cruise on the emerald waters of Lake Todos los Santos to marvel at the majesty of dramatic volcanic peaks. Then, savor a Patagonian barbecue at Ensenada Village.

**Nao Victoria Museum.** Delve into maritime history at this interactive museum. Explore a full-scale replica of Magellan's ship, the first to circumnavigate the globe. Continue to the Mirador Cerro de la Cruz lookout to bask in breathtaking panoramic views.

**Bernardo O'Higgins National Park.** Cruise the Última Esperanza Fjord while gazing at waterfalls, mountains and Patagonian birds. Stop to hike through the lush national park and be awed by the frozen natural wonders of the dramatic hanging Balmaceda Glacier and the Serrano Glacier's jagged peaks. Then, savor lunch at a Patagonian ranch.

**Torres del Paine National Park.** Revel in a spectacularly scenic drive to the acclaimed national park. Behold the visually arresting Horns of Paine and Lake Grey; and witness the raw power of the Salto Grande waterfall.
